MATTERS CONSIDERED BY THE ASSOCIATION TO BE OF UTMOST COMMUNITY IMPORTANCE:

1. Development & utilization of OUR 18 acre County Community Park.
2. Youth & Adult recreation program.
3. Community Public Utilities & Cost.
4. Streets, sidewalks, & gutters.
5. Civil Defense plans & training.
6. Group planning for home improvements to increase property value.
7. SNOW CLEARING & OFF STREET PARKING during inclement weather.
8. Pest & beetle control with aid of U. S. Agriculture Department.
9. Rezoning of properties that might HELP or HURT our community.
10. SHRUBERY & ENTRANCE signs to show OUR PRIDE IN OUR COMMUNITY.

Note: Some people think we have no EFFECTIVENESS: How can 15 or 20 ACTIVE members ever be able to provide the finance, leg work, administrative work and JUDGEMENT to begin caring for such matters when the remaining 1480 homes containing 2960 ADULTS do nothing, except for the 200 or so that joined after a door to door campaign last fall.

DECISION: Frankly, such a small group CANNOT represent a community when the community will not discuss and state its desires in matters that it is either in favor of, or against. The Association is represented at every County Federation meeting, and at many meetings of the Supervisors & School Board. However, many issues of IMPORTANCE have arisen when this representation had to ABSTAIN from casting THIS community' VOTE because NO KNOWLEDGE COULD BE OBTAINED AS TO HOW YOU AS A RESIDENT WANTED TO BE REPRESENTED.
